Poetry

General information

1. The poem selected must coincide with the age, personality and experience of the child. NB. **It is advisable to choose different poems for each entrant, in the event of more than one entrant per school, per section. Do not choose the same poem for all entrants from one school.**
 2. Natural presentation, obvious involvement and understanding of the poem is recommended.
 3. Avoid too many forced, unnatural movements.
 4. Natural body language is acceptable up to grade 6. From grade 7 and up, no movements are permissible.
 5. Make use of pauses, difference in tempo and variety of tone, to add interest to the presentation.
6. A copy of the poem **must** be handed to the adjudicator.
7. **In order to qualify for an award from grade 8 - 12 and the open section, participants must present both poems: prescribed as well as own choice.**
