General information

1. No dramatised prose allowed, No props allowed. Actions and movements must be **spontaneous** and limited to the bare minimum.
2. Time limit - **Grade 3 - 7: 2- 5 minutes. Grade 8 - Open: 3 - 6 minutes.**
3. The work must coincide with the age, personality and experience of the participant.
4. Only prose text may be used, no poetry. **Participants** will be penalised if text from a drama is used.
5. A copy **of** the extract must be handed to the adjudicator.
6. Extracts must be meaningful.
7. Books used must coincide with the specific age group.
8. In order to qualify for an award from grade 8 - open section, participants must present both poems: prescribed, as well as own choice.

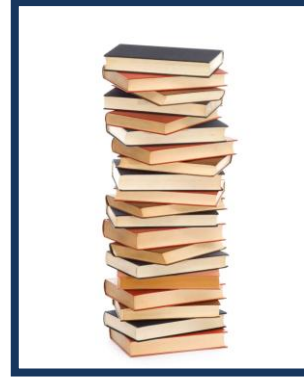
