4. Attempts to contact (before or after) the submission deadline or while adjudication is in progress, will result in immediate disqualification
ADJUDICATORS' DECISION IS FINAL.
5. **Age restriction:** Dancers must not be older than the said age on 1/8/2021.
6. Certificates will be awarded to all achievements 60% and above and medals to the top 3 candidates who achieve above 80%.
7. Only one certificate & one medal will be awarded to a group, with the choreography groups being an exception. Choreography will have a certificate & medal awarded to the choreographer, as well as every dancer that danced to assist the choreographer in presenting their work.
8. **Costumes & shoes** need to portray the style of dance presented.
9. **Make-up** is recommended for effective stage presentation.
10. **Hair** neatly done. Must also suit the style of dance represented, i.e. bun for classical dance & funky hairstyle for Hip Hop.
11. **No jewellery** allowed, except for medic alert bracelets.
12. Please ensure that dancers are entered in the correct category. Entrants may not change categories once the Eisteddfod has processed the entries. Last minute entries/ incorrectly entered entries CANNOT be dealt with on the day of the performance. **To ensure correct entries, download & print a copy of the syllabus (from website www.tygerbergeisteddfod.com) or purchase a printed copy from the administrative manager.**
13. **Coaches, teachers and dancers are allowed backstage**, however ONLY immediately before and during own performance.
This rule will apply in the event that a physical prize winners's concert is allowed to be organized during the Covid lock down.
Please be respectful and adhere strictly to this rule, as a gathering crowd of people backstage makes it entirely impossible to allow disturbance-free performance for the dancers on stage. Please also appoint a senior dancer or responsible parent to maintain discipline in the cloak rooms.
14. As 2021 TIE Dance Eisteddfod is taking on the format of a virtual competition, please ensure that your school/studio uses a reputable videographer to record your dancers' best performance on a planned and set date before the cut-off for submissions, so that it represents a true and ethical version of your dancers and their abilities.
15. Video recordings will have to be submitted via a portal on the website. Please make sure that your entries are clearly referenced with your school code and entry number, just as it has always been done at our physical eisteddfod.
16. Unmarked entries and poor quality videos will unfortunately be disqualified.
17. Choreography for all dance entries must clearly show an adherence to all Covid regulations of non-contact between dancers and rather include the clever use of space, exits and entries and by-passes that will demonstrate the strength and versatility of the dancers.
18. Sadly the Improvisation category will not be accommodated in the virtual eisteddfod.
