- Group sizes:** Small groups (Minimum 5 dancers and maximum 15 dancers).
Big groups (Minimum 16 dancers and maximum 35 dancers).

4. **Approaching/addressing adjudicators while adjudication is in progress, will result in immediate disqualification. ADJUDICATORS' DECISION IS FINAL.**
5. **Age restriction:** Dancers must not be older than the said age on 1/8/2019.
6. Certificates will be awarded to all achievements 60% and above and medals to the top 3 candidates who achieve **above** 80%.
7. Only one certificate & one medal will be awarded to a group, with the choreography groups being an exception. Choreography will have a certificate & medal awarded to the choreographer, as well as every dancer that danced to assist the choreographer in presenting their work.
8. **Costumes & shoes** need to portray the style of dance presented.
9. **Make-up** is recommended for effective stage presentation.
10. **Hair** neatly done. Must also suit the style of dance represented, i.e. bun for classical dance & funky hairstyle for Hip Hop.
11. **No jewellery** allowed, except for medic alert bracelets.
12. Please ensure that dancers are entered in the correct category. Entrants may not change categories once the Eisteddfod has processed the entries. Last minute entries/ incorrectly entered entries CANNOT be dealt with on the day of the performance. **To ensure correct entries, download & print a copy of the syllabus (from website www.tygerbergeisteddfod.com) or purchase a printed copy from the administrative manager.**
13. **Coaches, teachers and dancers are allowed backstage**, however ONLY immediately before and during own performance. Please be respectful and adhere strictly to this rule, as a gathering crowd of people backstage makes it entirely impossible to allow disturbance-free performance for the dancers on stage. Please also appoint a senior dancer or responsible parent to maintain discipline in the cloak rooms.
14. **Good quality CD's or music loaded on a flashdisk**, please! Each CD must be clearly marked with the category code, candidate number and track number. Flashdisks must also be clearly marked and a clearly detailed list provided with it for the soundman. Not adhering to the sound requirements will result in immediate disqualification if delays and problems are caused on the day. For 2019 teachers and coaches are going to be required to submit their sound cd's & flashdisks before the actual eisteddfod for a sound check and possible pre-loading. Dance educators are responsible for delivering cd's & flashdisks for a compulsory sound check which may or may not coincide with the pre-eisteddfod rehearsal. The sound check is **COMPULSORY!!!!**
15. **Pre-Eisteddfod rehearsals** are not compulsory, but if required, can be booked well in advance with the dance convenor. Hiring fees may be determined and applied by the dance convenor/dance committee.
1. **Dancers/competitors must report backstage** to the stage manager **with their entry tickets** at least 30 minutes BEFORE performing or risk being disqualified.
2. Due to extreme problems experienced previously, the eisteddfod committee reserves the right to disqualify participants/groups (even after marks have been awarded) whose teachers or parents insist on changes made to the programme ON THE DAY due to reasons that have nothing to do with the eisteddfod itself.
