#### GENERAL INFORMATION:

NB. **It is advisable to choose different poems for each entrant, in the event of more than one entrant per school, per section.** Do not choose the same poem for all entrants from one school.
2. Natural presentation, obvious involvement and understanding of the poem is recommended.
3. Avoid forced, unnatural gestures.
4. Natural body language is acceptable.
5. Make use of pauses, difference in tempo and variety of tone to add interest to the presentation.
6. A **copy** of the poem **must** be handed to the adjudicator.

7. In order to qualify for an award from grade 8 - 12 and the open section, participants must present both poems: prescribed as well as own choice.
8. All prescribed poems can be found at the end of the syllabus.
