- 2. Topics and instructions for CREATIVE WRITING: POETRY will be sent to participating schools via email on the previous morning of the above date. Therefore, please ensure that the administrative manager of the TIE is in possession of your **correct e-mail address**.
- 3. Schools must please appoint their **own supervisors**.
- 4. ENTRY CARDS: Participants are kindly requested to bring along their entry cards. VERY IMPORTANT: Completed entry cards must be attached to the script of the participant.
- 5. TIME CONFINES: Minimum: 1 hour. Maximum: 1½ hour.
- 6. HANDING IN OF SCRIPTS: Scripts of participants must be delivered to MONTE VISTA PRIMARY SCHOOL on/before **3 May 2024 at 15:00**. Please mark clearly: **ATTENTION: Mr. L. Blom: TIE**
- 7. UTENSILS PERMITTED: **Pencils** (gr. 4 & 5); **pens** (gr. 6 to open); pencil sharpeners, erasers and dictionaries. No cell phones or any other electronic devices will be allowed.
- 8. Number of words allowed for each grade:

Grade 4 - 7: 60 - 80 words

Grade 8 - 12: 80 - 120 words

- 9. IMPORTANT MATTERS which participants should take into consideration when writing their poems:
 - Is the topic of the poem clearly reflected in the poem?
 - Is there a crisp, original and interesting approach to the topic?
 - Is a specific atmosphere created?
 - Did the author use rhyming words? Are they applied effectively or does it just simply rhyme? It is senseless to concentrate on rhyming words at the cost of a clear portrayal of the subject/message of the poem. Sometimes it is even better if the poem does not rhyme at all.
 - Have all redundant words been omitted?
 - Does the construction of the poem complement that which is being depicted?
 - Does the rhythm harmonise with the content of the poem?

- Make use of fresh images and personal interpretations. They are more important than ornate words or well-known idiomatic expressions.
- Please be aware of the number of words permitted.
